B certificate in "Pedagogy" and "Fighting with The Poor"

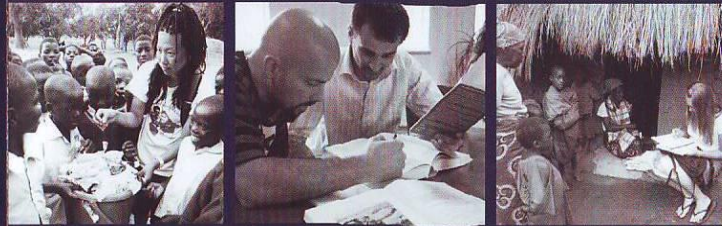
Gain a B-Certificate in Pedagogy and a B-Certificate in Fighting with The Poor: this program takes two important issues in the world of today and tackles them directly with both theoretical considerations and practice together with the people. The essence of the program points at, and fully accept the responsibility of the educated person to be part of transforming the societies where The Poor and poorer people of the world are to be found.

The people in our world are in need of teachers who have a high standard of ethics and practice and who know about the lives of the people they touch and nurture through their teachings. At the same time, our world is in need of activists who by realizing the existence of The Poor, understand the basis of his plight, and who raise their personal willingness, ability and readiness to fight the good fight, side by side with The Poor.

1st Period in Denmark: 12 months studies, investigations and action research on important issues connected to Pedagogy and Fighting with The Poor & saving up money for the program as an assistant teacher, promotion officer or working with second hand clothes collection

2nd period in Africa or India: 8 months volunteer work at a development project with 4 months focus on Pedagogy and 4 months focus on Fighting with The Poor. Studies in evenings and weekends

3rd period in Denmark: 2 months producing and spreading information and 2 months studies, evaluation and final exam.



Bachelor in Pedagogy

Bringing up and instructing children and youth to learn the skills and acquire the knowledge and wisdom they need to carry the future of humanity is no small task. Teachers are needed who know their trade, who possess a modern perspective of today's world, and who are willing to push the boundaries of tradition in search of ways and means of teaching and learning that will genuinely provide the new generation with the practical tools, the ethics and the human qualities they require to be able to take on life; as individuals, as progressive citizens of their country and as modern inhabitants and caretakers of the globe and its beings. The aim of OWU Licentiate Degree in Pedagogy is to train such teachers.

1st Year – The International Practice Field; includes 2 months in Denmark preparing for a 4 month bus travel; 4 months bus travel through the Sahara desert and 3 months of elaboration and spreading the work to people in Europe

2nd Year – The National Practice Field; includes 6 months training in experiences and understanding the national reality by living, working (seeking employment in factories and other work places), studying, and organising cultural events in a bigger European city; 3 months studying at the school and 3 months doing what you find most appropriate to do

3rd Year – The School Practice Field; includes 8 months training, working and understanding the reality of children and teachers by seeking employment in a European school; 4 months at the school studying and final exams

Fighting with The Poor - 18 Month Program

The geography of poverty today was not formed by infertility of soils, lack of materials or inferior ingenuity of people, but by a chain of historic events that take us back some 500 years. Likewise the future will be determined by influences outside the realm of ordinary people. Through this program we dare to look at the problems and big issues of our present time right in the eye, understanding the forces and politics at play. We dare to dream and envision a future for We the People and try to point to modern, lively, inclusive and sustainable ways and solutions.

1st period in Denmark: 3 months studies on important issues about our times; 3 months studies and debates to visualize the future of the world, it's problems and solutions

2nd period in Africa or India: 6 months living, working and fighting shoulder to shoulder with The Poor to improve their conditions

3rd period in Denmark/Europe: 6 months presentations, actions, journalism in the public arena and preparing for your future.



Fighting with The Poor - 24 Month Program

The aim of the education is to combine action with theoretical and practical knowledge within the framework of realizing the existence of The Poor, understanding the basis of his plight, and raising the personal wiliness, ability and readiness of the student to fight the good fight side by side with The Poor. This approach to study and to life as an educated person is new and is in many ways revolutionary as by training the student in the theories and practice of specific transformational processes in society, we point at and fully accept the responsibility of the educated person to be part of transforming that society.

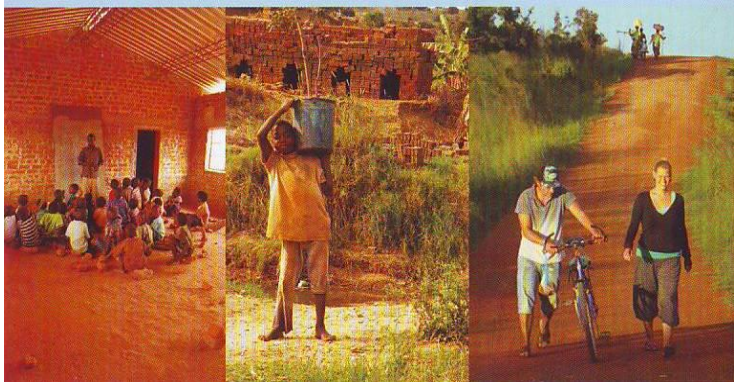
1st period in Denmark: 6 months training and studies in international relations specializing in North/South, Richer and The Poor.

2nd period: 3 months fundraising, working, saving up and preparing to travel.

3rd period: 3 months travel in groups of three to destination in the third World.

4th period in Africa or India: 6 months living, working and fighting shoulder to shoulder with The Poor to improve their conditions

5th period in Denmark/Europe: 6 months presentations, actions, journalism in the public arena and preparing for your future.
